II. PROCESSING OF YOUR PERSONAL DATA

1. What personal data are collected by the website?

The personal data collected by NFL BIOSCIENCES are as follows: your surname(s), first name, email address and phone number.

It is important to note that the form contains the following required fields:

- Surname and first name of the person concerned.
- Email address
- Message

In which case, the User may decide to not provide the following information:

- Phone number

2. Which parties collect your personal data via the website?

The collection and processing of personal data via the website and for the purposes of the services are carried out exclusively under the responsibility of NFL BIOSCIENCES, the data controller.

3. For what purposes do we collect your personal data?

We collect personal data exclusively with a view to informing the website's Users about NFL BIOSCIENCES' financial news.

4. On what basis are your personal data collected?

The processing of Users' personal data is based on their consent. This consent is collected using a form on which Users provide their personal data with a view to registering for a mailing list. Users may withdraw their consent at any time.

5. How long are your personal data kept for?

Your personal data cannot be retained on an active basis beyond the retention period that is strictly necessary for providing Users with information concerning NFL BIOSCIENCES' financial news.

Your personal data will therefore be retained until you submit an unsubscribe request to NFL BIOSCIENCES.

6. Who do we share your personal data with?

The personal data are processed by NFL BIOSCIENCES and the agency CALYPTUS.

7. Are your personal data transferred outside the European Union?

Infomaniak, 25 Eugène-Marziano, 1227 Les Acacias, Swiss, hosts the data from the NFL BIOSCIENCES site.

8. How do we ensure the security of your personal data?

NFL BIOSCIENCES puts in place various measures intended to ensure the security of the website and its services. It therefore protects your personal data against any access by unauthorized third parties.

9. How can you exercise your rights concerning your personal data?

Under the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR), you have several rights relating to your data:

- **Right of access** concerning your data, i.e. the right to be provided with the data concerning you, in paper or digital format.
- **Right to rectification** concerning your data, i.e. the possibility to get the data controller to modify any inaccurate or incomplete data concerning you.
- **Right to erasure** concerning your data, i.e. the right to have your data erased, subject to legal and regulatory provisions, public interest, exercising freedom of expression or information, or for the establishment, exercise or defense of legal claims.
- **Right to restriction of processing** concerning your data. This right is intended to support the other rights, such as the right to rectification or the right to object. The data controller may take a certain period of time to review your request. You may therefore ask for the processing of your data to be put on hold. During the time when this right is exercised, we will be able to process your data exclusively in the following cases:

- You have given your consent;
 - For the establishment, exercise or defense of legal claims;
 - For the protection of the rights of another natural or legal person;
 - For reasons of important public interest of the European Union or of a Member State.
- **Right to object** concerning your data on grounds relating to your particular situation. However, when your data are processed for prospecting purposes, it is not necessary to indicate your situation, as this right to object is set out by law.
 - **Right to the portability** of your data, i.e. the possibility to recover part of your data in a machine-readable format or to have your data transmitted by the initial data controller to another controller of your choice. Nevertheless, this right exclusively concerns data collected from you based on a contract or your consent, and processed by automated means.
